Anyone wishing to receive a prayer and blessing will be invited to come forward. Participation is not compulsory, but all, including visitors to Holy Trinity, are welcome.

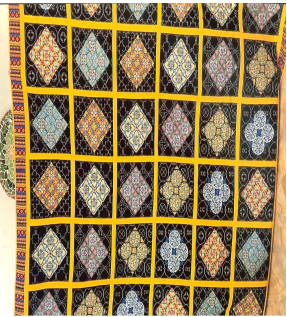
## Spotlight on Ministry: India, The Philippines, Ecuador & Haiti
