Altar Flowers

The dry, barren branches which adorn the Altar during the season of Lent remind us of Jesus' 40 days of fasting in the desert. We read of this event on the First Sunday of Lent, BCP page 125, which sets the tone for the Holy Season. (At Holy Trinity Anglican Church, these are affectionately called "the holy sticks!")

Hosted by Rabbi Schwartz. Limited Seating (68). **Reservations Required!** For the first time Holy Trinity Church will host a traditional Passover Meal with a special guest as our leader, Rabbi Martin Schwartz, the Jewish Chaplain for Hospitals in Northeast Florida. The Seder has its own liturgy and includes:

- Four cups of wine
- Celery dipped in saltwater
- Flat, dry cracker-like bread called matzah
- Bitter herbs (horseradish without additives) and romaine lettuce, dipped into charoset (a paste of nuts, apples, and wine).

A festive meal that may contain time-honored favorites, this year will serve Lenten soup and salad.

Rabbi Schwartz will lead us through the meal explaining all the rich symbolism and meaning behind each dish, including the food served to a particular Old Testament prophet who is always welcome to visit every Seder/Passover meal.

Though seating is limited, guests are certainly welcome. Please make reservations through the office or by signing the reservation sheet located on the information table in Scott-King Hall.
