Altar Creche

During Advent, the Altar features a Creche or Manger Scene. On the First Sunday in Advent the Creche is empty, with only the animals and the shepherd present in the stable. Each week, the scene will grow. On Christmas Eve the baby Jesus will appear in the manger. The Creche will not be complete until the Feast of the Epiphany (January 6) when the three wise men arrive.
