For the five Sundays following Resurrection Sunday we will use a special consecration prayer during our Services. Taken from the Liturgy of 1549 with additional elements from Anglican Missals, the EASTERTIDE Liturgy is available in Mass booklets located in the Narthex.

## Rogation Sunday and Rogation Days



Rogation days are days of prayer and fasting in Western Christianity. They are observed with processions and the Litany of the Saints. The so-called *major* rogation is held Sunday; the *minor* rogations are held on Monday to Wednesday preceding Ascension Thursday. The word *rogation* comes from the Latin verb *rogare*, meaning "to ask", which reflects the beseeching of God for the appeasement of his anger and for protection from calamities.

A common feature of Rogation days in former times was the ceremony of *beating the bounds*, in which a procession of parishioners, led by the minister, churchwarden, and choirboys, would proceed around the boundary of their parish and pray for its protection in the forthcoming year.
