## Diocesan Synod and Provincial Synods in Atlanta, July 20<sup>th</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup>

Following postponement from last year, our Anglican Church meetings will take place concurrently this year. At the Diocesan Synod for the DEUS (Diocese of the Eastern US) we will see the retirement of our Bishop Ordinary Walter Grundorf and the enthronement of Coadjutor Chad Jones as our new Bishop Ordinary. At the Provincial Synod we will deal with who shall become Presiding Bishop of the APA after Bishop Grundorf officially steps down. There will also be meetings of a plethora of committees, each tasked with keeping the various ministries of our Church strong and in good order.

Fr. Peter Joslyn along with his family will join Fr. Brad Cunningham and Diana in representing Holy Trinity Church and Lindisfarne Hall. The official parish lay delegates are Benjamin Cunningham and Diana Cunningham. The official lay deputy to the Provincial Synod is Benjamin Cunningham.
