## What's In A Name: CATHOLIC

Every Sunday during Mass and every day during the Daily Offices we confess our belief in the Catholic Church. Whether declaring our faith in the words of the Nicene Creed, the Apostles' Creed or the Athanasian Creed, there is no ambiguity - we are upper-case "C" Catholic.\*

The word Catholic was first used to describe the Church by St. Ignatius of Antioch. Ignatius was himself a disciple of St. John the Apostle, and is said to have been one of the children who sat on Jesus' knee. The historian Eusebius recorded that Ignatius was made Bishop of Antioch at the instruction of none other than St. Peter. So the church has been described as Catholic since the time of the Apostles and the writing of the New Testament.

But what does Catholic mean? That was defined by St. Vincent of Lerins in what is now called the Vincentian Canon. He said the Catholic Faith is "quod ubique, quod semper, quod ab omnibus creditum est - what has been believed everywhere, always and by all." This triple test is an immensely valuable way to differentiate between the Faith "once for all delivered to the Saints," and sectarian teachings that do not truly belong to Christianity.

For example, the Church has always and everywhere believed that Jesus is the Son of God, that Mary is a perpetual virgin, that Sacraments are a means of grace, etc., and all faithful Christians have consented to these truths.

Conversely, there were times when some taught that Mary was not a Virgin (fails the always test), and there were places where Sacraments were disregarded (fails the everywhere test) and there were people who rebelled against the deity of Jesus (fails the everyone test. And every other test!).

So when we claim to be Catholic, we are claiming the whole faith of all ages and also rejecting what does not belong to the Christian Faith: We will have Christ, nothing more but nothing less. In other words, we are Catholic.

*When we say we believe in one Catholic Church, we confess a very specific faith, not simply a generic (lower case) faith.*
