1. **Wear something purple**, the liturgical color of the season.
2. **Begin a reading of Genesis**, according to the traditional discipline on the Christian Church.
3. **Prep for the Lenten Fast.** Gather your favorite vegetarian recipes and find a few new ones you would like to try.
4. **Eat Pancakes!** Join us for Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper, February 13th
