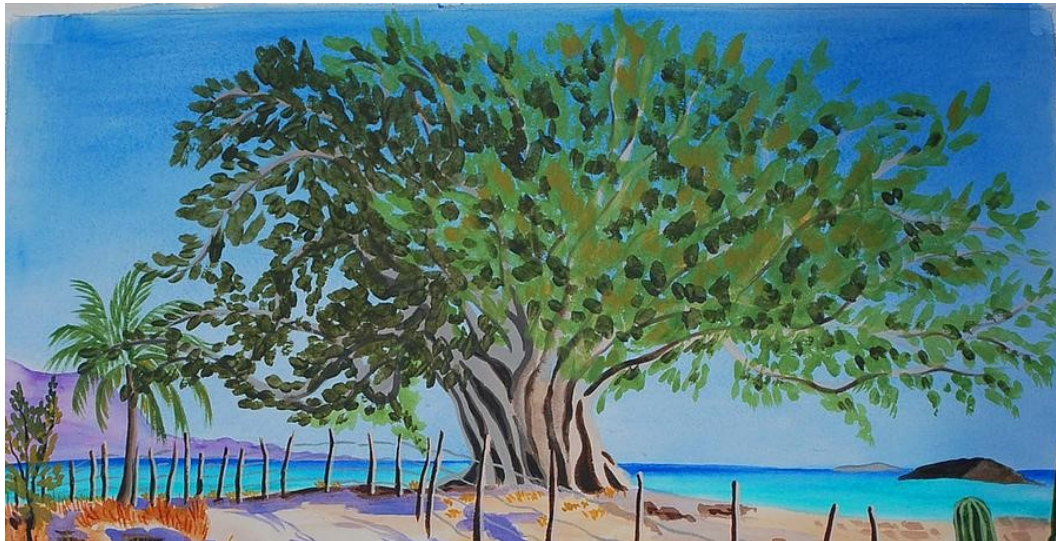

Anglican Catechism Moment:

An Outline of the Book of Common Prayer

The traditional Book of Common Prayer (as opposed to most contemporary adaptations) is designed for usefulness according to a very logical progression. The success of its arrangement is demonstrated by its ease of use and comprehensive relevance to contemporary life. The BCP's liturgies follow a specific order: Daily prayers and devotions; weekly services and readings; common liturgies for life (from birth to death); and occasional liturgies in the life of the Church (ordinations and dedications). Below is an outline of the Book of Common Prayer as it is intended to be used and useful in your life:

The DAILY Prayers of every Christian

Lectionary (Scripture readings for every morning and evening of the year)

Morning Prayer (prayers for each morning of the year)

Evening Prayer (prayers for each evening of the year)

Prayers and Thanksgivings (a section of collect type prayers which may be added to Morning or Evening Prayer or used as separate devotions)

The WEEKLY Prayers of every Christian

Holy Communion

The Propers (Collects, Epistles and Gospels to be used throughout the year)

OCCASSIONAL Liturgies for special occasions

(in order of how they ordinarily occur in the course of life)

Holy Baptism (entrance into the Church and the Christian life)

Confirmation (the gift of the Holy Spirit for the maturity of the Christian life)

Holy Matrimony (the sacrament creating a family)

Thanksgiving after Childbirth

Visitation / Communion of the Sick (along with "Last Rites")

The Burial of the Dead (the transition from this world to the next)

The Psalter (The Psalms as translated by Myles Coverdale, published in 1553.)

The ORDINAL (The least common services are last in the BCP)

The Ordination of a Deacon

The Ordination of a Priest

The Consecration of a Bishop

The Consecration of a Church or Chapel

The Institution of Ministers into Parishes or Churches
