## Anglican Catechism Moment: We sing with Angels & 4 Faced Creatures

Christian worship is based on the worship of heaven as revealed through Moses and the prophets in the Old Testament and through St. John and the Revelation of Jesus Christ in the New Testament. One of the most important elements of Christian worship is called the Sanctus (The Holy, Holy, Holy). This song first appears in Isaiah 6, who saw and heard the angels of heaven singing this song; Ezekiel also heard this anthem. Finally, St. John was granted a vision of heaven as recorded in the book of Revelation. As he saw the Lamb of God seated upon the Throne of Glory, he also heard the Cherubim and Seraphim singing the Sanctus. And so, we sing the Sanctus with them. Note: we do not imitate the angels. We are simply joining in with them as they worship God in the everlasting liturgy of heaven. When we sing today in the Liturgy, we are singing *WITH* angels, creatures, saints and martyrs!
