Changes to Administration of Holy Communion

- If you do not have a preference, make your way to the side of the Altar with the most space.

Anglican Catechism Moment: Prayer Book "Propers"

The word proper here means "required, suitable or appropriate." The Book of Common Prayer supplies every Sunday, Feast Day, and Sacrament with a suitable and appropriate prayer, Scripture reading, Psalm and Gospel readings. In the Church, these are called "The Propers for the Day," or "Propers" for short. Today is the 14th Sunday after Trinity, and the Propers are found on pages 209-210 in the Book of Common Prayer. The Propers are also listed in the side column of the Trinity Times. FYI, the Propers follow a particular logic, which will be the subject of a future ACM (*Anglican Catechism Moment*).
