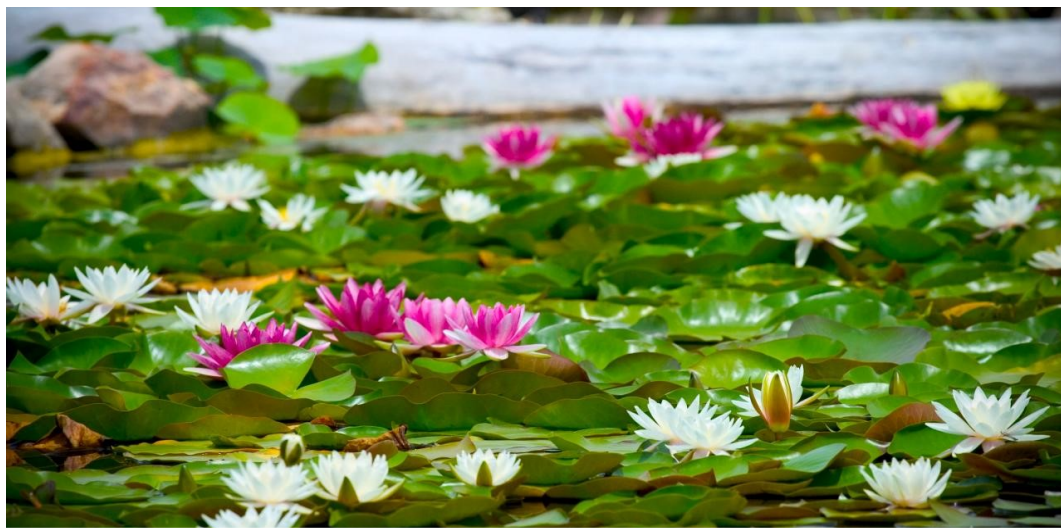

Changes to Distribution of Holy Communion

- To receive Holy Communion by intinction and directly on the tongue, as we have since 2020, go to the Gospel side of the Altar rail (pulpit side).
- To receive Holy Communion directly from the common cup, go to the Epistle side of the Altar rail (lectern side).
- If you do not have a preference, make your way to the side of the Altar with the most space.

Catechism Moment: Redeeming Time with the Church Calendar

Psalm 90:12 states, *“Teach us to number our days, that we may present to you a heart of wisdom.”* Beginning in the book of Exodus, the people of God have observed a liturgical Calendar that “numbers the days” and is designed to bring order to our lives and assist us in growing in grace. When understood rightly, the Church calendar is a great gift; when used regularly, the Church Calendar redeems the time of our life, making our days and seasons useful for our flourishing and pleasing to God. St. Paul wrote, *“Look carefully how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, redeeming the time for the days are evil.”* (Ephesians 5:15-16)
