Changes to Distribution of Holy Communion

- To receive Holy Communion by intinction and directly on the tongue, as we have since 2020, go to the Gospel side of the Altar rail (pulpit side).
- To receive Holy Communion directly from the common cup, go to the Epistle side of the Altar rail (lectern side).
- If you do not have a preference, make your way to the side of the Altar with the most space.

Catechism Moment: Bishops, Priests and Deacons, O My!

BCP p. 294

Q. What orders of Ministers are there in the Church?

A. Bishop’s, Priests, and Deacons; which orders have been in the Church from the earliest times.

Q. What is the office of a Bishop?

A. The office of a bishop is to be a chief pastor in the Church; to confer Holy Orders; and to administer Confirmation.

Q. What is the office of a Priest?

A. The office of a Priest is, to minister to the people committed to his care; to preach the Word of God; to Baptize; to celebrate Holy Communion; and to pronounce Absolution and Blessing in God’s Name.
