The Prayer of St. Michael

For a century, when the church faced severe persecution from secular kings and armies, whenever Christians celebrated Holy Communion the service was dismissed with the following Prayer of St. Michael:

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle; be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray: and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, thrust into hell satan and all of the other evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. *Amen*

The Distribution of Holy Communion

- To receive Holy Communion by intinction and directly on the tongue, as we have since 2020, go to the Gospel side of the Altar rail (pulpit side).
- To receive Holy Communion directly from the common cup, go to the Epistle side of the Altar rail (lectern side).
- If you do not have a preference, make your way to the side of the Altar with the most space.

Catechism Moment: Angels in the Bible and in Our Lives

St. Augustine taught, "Angel is the name of their office, not of their nature. If you seek the name of their nature, it is spirit; if you seek the name of their office it is angel; from what they are, 'spirit', from what they do, 'angel.'" With their whole beings the angels are servants and messengers of God. Because they "always behold the face of my Father who is in heaven" they are the "mighty ones who do his word, harkening to the voice of his word."

The existence of the spiritual, non-corporeal beings that sacred Scripture usually calls angels is a truth of the faith. The witness of Scripture is as clear as the unanimity of Tradition.
