## The Distribution of Holy Communion

- To receive Holy Communion by intinction and directly on the tongue, as we have since 2020, go to the Gospel side of the Altar rail (pulpit side).
- To receive Holy Communion directly from the common cup, go to the Epistle side of the Altar rail (lectern side).
- If you do not have a preference, make your way to the side of the Altar with the most space.

## Catechism Moment: God and the Cosmos

The most famous verse in the New Testament is John 3:16 which reads, "For God so loved the COSMOS that he gave his only begotten Son..." The Greek word cosmos (κόσμος) means the universe. God loves us *and* he also loves his whole creation. And because he loves his whole creation - galaxies, stars, planets, oceans, trees, fish and every creeping thing and mankind, the crown of his cosmos - he sent his son into the cosmos to save it. In St. Mark 16:15, Jesus gives his Great Commission as he ascends into heaven, "Go into all the world (cosmos) and proclaim the Gospel to the whole creation."

Last Friday we celebrated the Feast Day of St. Francis of Assisi, a man famous for his devotion to the creation beloved of God. Through the coming days, let us contemplate God's love for mankind, and also his love for the whole of his creation - his cosmos.
