Should you wish to support any of these 501(c)3 missions monetarily, donate in-kind merchandise or volunteer at their locations, please do the following:

HOPE HOUSE – Make checks payable to **Nassau County Hope House, 410 S. 9th Street, Fernandina Beach, FL 32034**. To volunteer, contact **Mary Moore, 904-321-0435**. Bring in-kind donations of non-perishable food or gently used clothing to the Parish Hall and deposit in the box on the cart behind the beverage table marked “**HOPE HOUSE.**” A list of needed items is attached to the box. **Tom Raymond** will deliver to Hope House weekly. They provide services, food and clothing to the homeless and needy in Nassau County.

MICAH'S PLACE – Make checks payable to **Micah's Place, P. O. Box 16287, Fernandina Beach, FL 32035**. To volunteer, call 904-491-6364, Ext. 6. There is another box on the cart behind the beverage table in the Parish Hall marked “**MICAH'S PLACE**” which also has a list of needed items attached. Please deposit your donations there. Lois Laing will deliver to Micah's Place weekly. They are Nassau County's only shelter for survivors of domestic violence. They also operate two resale shops in the county called the **PURPLE DOVE**, one on the east and west side which are staffed by volunteers.

NASSAU COUNTY COUNCIL ON AGING (COA) – Make checks payable to the **Nassau County Council on Aging, 1367 S. 18th Street, Fernandina Beach, FL 32034** until October 22, 2018. They will be in their new, larger location at **1901 Island Walkway, Fernandina Beach, FL 32034** where they will be offering expanded services. To volunteer or use their services, call 904-261-0701. Transportation is available for seniors for a small fee by calling 904-261-0700. AMERICA'S YOUTH, INC. – Provides disadvantaged youth who are economically distressed with skills to reduce juvenile crime, instill positive values, character and leadership skills, host events, access to information technology and related training.
